I would like to highlight some of our accomplishments thus far this school year:

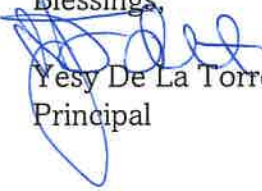
- We have updated our school mission statement this year to better align with our Catholic identity.
