Greetings Parents,

Below, you will find a list of guidelines for specific uniforms to purchase as well as standards for hair, jewelry, etc.

****Please note: It is not the uniform store's responsibility to monitor skirt length. Please purchase skirts at an appropriate length so that they meet requirements when school begins. Students will be asked to purchase a longer skirt if necessary.**

The uniform store will guide you as to the type of clothing you need to buy. Please note that uniforms for grades K-5 are different than those from the middle school uniforms for grades 6-8. If your child is moving to middle school, they will need new uniforms. Official uniforms are to be worn on Fridays and apply to all grades K-8.

Guidelines:

- Plain navy or black belts are always required for boys.
- Girls' skirt hems should fall at the **top of the knee**. Please monitor this as girls get taller throughout the year or may have grown from the previous year.



- Shoes should be black dress shoes for boys (no sneakers) and black Mary-Jane style shoes or penny loafers (K-5) or penny-loafers (6-8) for girls.
- On designated P.E. days, students must wear a gray Mother of Christ P.E. shirt and navy Mother of Christ P.E. shorts (**not to be worn tightly or short**). These are available at Risse Uniform. No other shirts or shorts will be allowed.

- Sneakers can be any variation of colors **within blue, black, gray, or white.** Please do not purchase bright-colored sneakers that include, but are not limited to, turquoise, aqua, red, yellow, green, purple, or pink. No lighted sneakers are permitted.
- Daily uniform includes wearing navy M.O.C. socks available at Risse Uniform. No other socks will be permitted including P.E. days (No basketball socks allowed).
- Sweaters/sweatshirts must be purchased from the uniform store or a crew neck sweatshirt can be purchased from the Mother of Christ office for \$28.
- On denim days and field trips, students are to wear the navy-blue Crusader shirt that can be purchased in the school office for \$16.
- Nail polish or makeup is not permitted. Makeup will be removed immediately, and students will have until the next day to remove nail polish.
- No trendy haircuts will be permitted (including but not limited to faux-hawks, mullets (shorter on the sides than the back), buzzed lines, or designs). Boys' hair must be cut **above the collar and ear.** The front must be cut at or over the eyebrows. It must be combed neatly. Dyed or highlighted hair is NOT permitted. Any issues with inappropriate haircuts/hair dye must be remedied by the NEXT school day.



- Girls may wear **ONE pair** of small stud earrings or ear lobe huggers. Hoop or dangling earrings are NOT permitted for safety reasons.
- Students may wear one small gold/silver religious chain and one simple bracelet. Chokers and multiple bracelets are not allowed.

Please help us by adhering to these guidelines when making your purchases so you will not have to make changes as the school year begins. We thank you for your cooperation.
